

# Instructions for wear checks of play equipment

The equipment must be checked for correct operation and safety, especially the points listed below:

Proof of maintenance

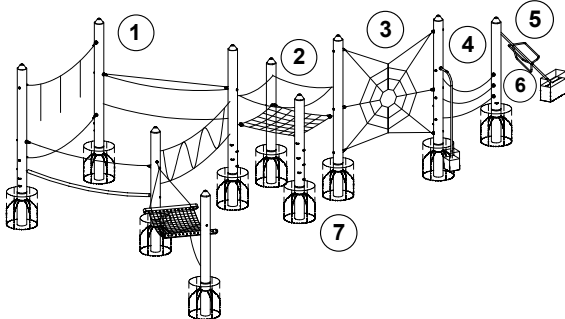
Checks depend on the type of equipment. Any equipment with moving parts must be checked at least twice a year, static equipment at least once a year.


Intervals for maintenance work and checks generally depend on

- location
- usage
- frequency of use
- possible vandalism

Strictly adhere to the maintenance intervals!

## Concrete

1. Check for vandalism (chipped edges), and if necessary deburr sharp edges with an angle grinder or mend them with fast drying concrete or epoxy resin.

## Ropes and nets

2. Check the connections of rope and net elements for damage and ensure they are tight, retighten if necessary.
3. Check plastic sleeves of rope and net elements for wear and tear; replace any elements whose inner steel strands are damaged.

## Whisk and firemen's pole

4. Check the connections to the concrete column and retighten if necessary.
5. Whisk: Ensure that the whisk rotates smoothly(brass bushes).
6. Check weld seams for strength (cracks), if necessary re-weld and grind down in a competent manner.

## Structural stability

7. Have trained personnel check the condition of the concrete columns **twice** a year. Dig around the columns down to the foundation before carrying out this step.
